Rachel Llyod GEMS Founder & President

In 1998, at just 23 years old, Rachel Lloyd founded Girls Educational and Mentoring Services (GEMS) at her kitchen table with \$30 and a borrowed computer. She was driven by the lack of services for commercially sexually exploited and domestically trafficked girls and young

women and the incredible stigma and punishment they faced from service providers, law enforcement, the courts, their families and society.

Nineteen years later, GEMS is now the largest service provider of its kind in the nation providing intensive services and support to over 450 girls and young women, preventive outreach and education to 1,500 youth, and training over 1,300 professionals each year.

Rachel is well-known for her tireless dedication to 'her girls' and has impacted thousands of individual lives through her love and commitment, but she is also passionate about changing public perception and policy.

Rachel received her Bachelor's degree in Psychology from Marymount Manhattan College and her Master's in Applied Urban Anthropology from the City College of New York.

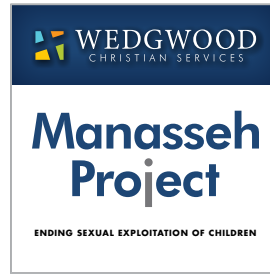
